

Student Affairs is committed to engaging the KU community in services and programs that make learning possible. The information presented below highlights our work for March 2019.

LEGAL SERVICES FOR STUDENTS

After participating in LSS' income tax workshops, 82% of participants strongly agreed they are better equipped to manage their tax preparation in the future, a 4% increase from 2018.

WATKINS HEALTH SERVICES

In March, a total of 200 students spoke with staff about travel health concerns and received safer spring break kits at Watkins' Pop-Up Clinic in the Kansas Union.

COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

CAPS assisted a total of 659 students, an increase of more than 23% from March 2018.

STUDENT MONEY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

SMMS staff assisted a total of 18 students through individual initial appointments, an increase of more than 63% from March 2018.

KU RECREATION SERVICES

KU Fit hosted its first Cyclates Event classes with a total of 19 student participants.

HILLTOP CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

Hilltop Child Development Center had a total enrollment of 305 children, an increase of more than 5% from March 2018.

STUDENT CONDUCT AND COMMUNITY STANDARDS

In March, there were a total of 527 conduct-related incidents reported, a decrease of more than 13% from March 2018.

SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & EDUCATION CENTER

SAPEC facilitated a total of 20 trainings, an increase of more than 17% from March 2018.

KU MEMORIAL UNION

KU Memorial Union hosted its first Rita Ravens Alexander Leadership retreat with a total of 32 student leader participants.

KU STUDENT HOUSING

KU Student Housing hosted its first Stouffer Place Open House event with approximately 40 student attendees.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT & LEADERSHIP CENTER

After participating in SILC's Adding to Your Leadership Toolbox: Leadership & Resumes program, 100% of student participants felt they gained a better understanding of how to best format their resume.
