

As a division, Student Affairs is committed to engaging the KU community in services and programs that complement students' academic goals and enhance their quality of life. The information presented below highlights our work for March 2017.

KU RECREATION SERVICES

Ambler Student Recreation Fitness Center had 3,470 student visits during Spring Break.

STUDENT MONEY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

SMMS Peer Educators assisted a total of 15 students in one-on-one appointments during the month of March.

SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & EDUCATION CENTER

A total of 264 people participated in *Consent 101* and *Consent 102* trainings during the month of March.

KU MEMORIAL UNION

As of March 2017, KJHK's YouTube Channel has received more than 635,000 views.

COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

CAPS had 1,115 appointments during the month of March, an increase of more than 5% from March 2016.

STUDENT CONDUCT & COMMUNITY STANDARDS

After participating in the student conduct process, 81% of students felt meeting with a hearing officer helped them consider how their behaviors impact their academic success.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT & LEADERSHIP CENTER

In March, 60 students participated in the annual Blueprints Leadership Conference.

HILLTOP CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

As of March, 36% of children enrolled at Hilltop are those of KU students.

KU STUDENT HOUSING

Based on a 7-point scale, *Skyfactor* survey data revealed that students' satisfaction with safety and security (5.75), hall/apartment staff (5.70), and community environment (5.50) remains strong.

LEGAL SERVICES FOR STUDENTS

After participating in LSS income tax workshops, 76% of participants strongly agreed they are better equipped to handle their tax preparation in the future.

WATKINS HEALTH SERVICES

After participating in the Alcohol CHOICES course, 73% of students felt the course was very effective in describing strategies to make lower-risk drinking choices.

In addition, as a result of participating in the Alcohol CHOICES course, 84% of students indicated they either would or may make changes in their behavior.
