

Student Affairs is committed to engaging the KU community in services and programs that make learning possible. The information presented below highlights our work for June, July, and August 2018.

STUDENT MONEY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

SMMS peer educators assisted 158 individuals during summer 2018, an increase of more than 182% from summer 2017.

KU MEMORIAL UNION

In August, the Kansas Union's annual UnionFest was attended by a total of 8,817 individuals, an increase of more than 7% from 2017.

HILLTOP CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

In August, Hilltop Child Development Center had a total enrollment of 310 children, compared to 314 in August 2017.

STUDENT CONDUCT & COMMUNITY STANDARDS

After participating in SCCS training, 100% of KU Student Housing graduate staff indicated they understood the role conduct plays in the residential curriculum.

KU RECREATION SERVICES

During June and July, KU Recreation Services' KU Fit Program had a total of 318 participants, an increase of more than 25% from 2017.

COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

CAPS had a total of 1,705 appointments during June, July, and August, an increase of more than 16% from 2017.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT & LEADERSHIP CENTER

A total of 709 women accepted chapter bids during Panhellenic Sorority Recruitment, compared to 794 women in 2017.

LEGAL SERVICES FOR STUDENTS

After using LSS' services during summer 2018, 95% of clients felt they acquired skills or knowledge that better equipped them to handle future legal situations.

KU STUDENT HOUSING

KU Student Housing provided on-campus housing for 29 groups or camps during June, an increase of more than 20% from June 2017.

WATKINS HEALTH SERVICES

Watkins Health Services assisted 434 students during International Student Orientation, an increase of more than 8% from 2017.

SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & EDUCATION CENTER

A total of 3,906 incoming freshmen completed SAPEC's *Jayhawks Give a Flock!* training on August 18th, 22% higher than the total number of students trained over the past two academic years combined.
