CENTER FOR SEXUALITY & GENDER DIVERSITY

In March, the SGD Center had **129 visitors**, an increase of more than 44% from the previous month.

COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

CAPS conducted **112 initial assessments**, an increase of more than 160% from March 2020.

EMILY TAYLOR CENTER FOR WOMEN & GENDER EQUITY

As of March, ETC allocated **100% of the KU Women for KU Women Fund** to students needing assistance in fulfilling their educational and career goals.

HILLTOP CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

In response to a recent survey, **64% of student parents** felt Hilltop helped them graduate from KU sooner.

KU MEMORIAL UNION

KJHK received **46 volunteer staff and DJ applications**, an increase of more than 12% from spring 2020.

KU RECREATION SERVICES

Ambler Student Recreation Fitness Center had **32,400 access card swipes**, an increase of more than 17% from the previous month.

KU STUDENT HOUSING

In March, **82 undergraduate staff members** indicated a desire to return to their role next academic year, an increase of more than 6% from last year.

LEGAL SERVICES FOR STUDENTS

LSS met all VITA grant site requirements and received a **100% score**, following an IRS remote site audit conducted by the IRS.

OFFICE OF MULTICULTURAL AFFAIRS

In March, **68 KU community members** participated in the OMA's Free Lunch for Students Program.

SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & EDUCATION CENTER

SAPEC facilitated **13 trainings and awareness events**, a 30% increase from March 2020.

SORORITY & FRATERNITY LIFE

In March, **29 prospective students** participated in the Multicultural Greek Council (MGC) and National Pan-Hellenic Council (NPHC) virtual Preview Day event. Also, **74 prospective students** participated in the Interfraternity Council (IFC) virtual Preview Day event.

STUDENT CONDUCT & COMMUNITY STANDARDS

After participating in Hawk Habits, **100% of participants** felt the workshop helped them clarify their personal values, ethics, and social identities.
