

Student Affairs is committed to engaging the KU community in services and programs that make learning possible. The information presented below highlights our work for March 2018.

STUDENT MONEY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

In March, SMMS presented to a total of 62 students and community members.

KU STUDENT HOUSING

In March, a total of 158 students accepted positions as Resident Assistants, Food Board Managers, and Proctors for the 2018-2019 academic year.

KU RECREATION SERVICES

Since its opening, a total of four Sports Club events have taken place at the new Central District recreation field.

KU MEMORIAL UNION

The KJHK Facebook page had a total daily page reach of 61,559, an increase of more than 24% from March 2017.

LEGAL SERVICES FOR STUDENTS

After participating in LSS income tax workshops, 78% of participants strongly agreed they are better equipped to manage their tax preparation in the future.

HILLTOP CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

As of March, 87 children enrolled at Hilltop are those of KU Students, compared to 104 in March 2017.

WATKINS HEALTH SERVICES

In an effort to promote student health and safety, WHS distributed 1,500 Safer Spring Break Kits containing sunscreen, hand sanitizer, first aid and safe sex kits, and information from SAPEC and the KU Public Safety Office.

STUDENT CONDUCT & COMMUNITY STANDARDS

SCCS has provided 21.5 hours of training and classroom presentations on the student conduct process, an increase of 330% from this time last year.

SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & EDUCATION CENTER

In March, SAPEC conducted a total of 17 trainings, an 89% increase from March 2017.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT & LEADERSHIP CENTER

SILC received a total of 24 Nontraditional student scholarship applications, an increase of 50% from March 2017.

COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

CAPS had a total of 44 triage and urgent care visits, an increase of more than 18% from February 2018.
