

Student Affairs is committed to engaging the KU community in services and programs that make learning possible. The information presented below highlights our work for September 2018.

STUDENT MONEY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

In September, SMMS staff assisted 52 individuals, an increase of more than 18% from September 2017.

KU MEMORIAL UNION

In September, 72% of individuals attending the annual SUA Campus Carnival were KU Student Housing residents, an increase of more than 5% from September 2017.

HILLTOP CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

During September, Hilltop Child Development Center employed a total of 68 KU students, an increase of more than 4% from September 2017.

STUDENT CONDUCT & COMMUNITY STANDARDS

After participating in SCCS training, 100% of staff and graduate student participants indicated they were provided with enough information to facilitate *HawkHabits* sessions.

KU RECREATION SERVICES

KU Recreation Services held a total of 348 personal training sessions, an increase of more than 30% from September 2017.

COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

In September, CAPS assisted a total of 503 students, an increase of more than 25% from 2017.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT & LEADERSHIP CENTER

A total of 530 student organizations registered for the 2018 - 2019 academic year, compared to 591 in 2017 - 2018.

LEGAL SERVICES FOR STUDENTS

LSS was awarded a \$30,065 VITA grant from the IRS to continue its tax preparation assistance efforts, an increase of more than \$10,000 from 2017.

KU STUDENT HOUSING

As part of KU Student Housing's newly restructured Residential Curriculum, more than 500 residents attended at least one of five marquee events with an undergraduate staff member.

WATKINS HEALTH SERVICES

As of September, 54% of daily scheduled appointments were being checked in using Watkins Health Services' newly installed self check-in kiosks.

SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & EDUCATION CENTER

SAPEC launched its Gender Based Violence Prevention Seminar course with a total of 41 student participants.
