

Student Affairs is committed to engaging the KU community in services and programs that make learning possible. The information presented below highlights our work for June, July, and August 2019.

WATKINS HEALTH SERVICES

WHS assisted 424 students during International Student Orientation, compared to 434 students in the previous year.

KU STUDENT HOUSING

In August, a total of 496 volunteers assisted with student move-in, an increase of more than 27% from 2018.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT & LEADERSHIP CENTER

In August, 185 student organizations tabled at HawkFest, an increase of more than 21% from 2018.

HILLTOP CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

In August, Hilltop had a total enrollment of 308 children, compared to 310 children in August 2018.

STUDENT CONDUCT AND COMMUNITY STANDARDS

During June, July and August, SCCS had a total of 39 cases, a 125% decrease from 2018.

SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & EDUCATION CENTER

SAPEC had a successful launch of its Gender Based Violence Prevention Seminar, with 687 students enrolled in the offered 24 sections.

KU MEMORIAL UNION

In August, the Kansas Union's annual UnionFest was attended by a record breaking 10,292 individuals, an increase of 17% from 2018.

KU RECREATION SERVICES

In July, there were a total of 12,837 access card swipes at Ambler SRFC, an increase of 16% from July 2018.

LEGAL SERVICES FOR STUDENTS

After using LSS' services during summer 2019, 96% of clients felt they could demonstrate an understanding of the legal options related to their case.

COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

CAPS had a total of 2,020 appointments during June, July, and August, an increase of more than 19% from 2018.

STUDENT MONEY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

SMMS had an increase in initial appointments from 22 in August 2018 to 32 in August 2019, a 45% increase.

STUDENT SUPPORT AND CASE MANAGEMENT

Student Support and Case Management managed a total of 42 student cases, which is consistent with summer 2018 numbers.
