

Student Affairs is committed to engaging the KU community in services and programs that make learning possible. The information presented below highlights our work for November 2019.

STUDENT CONDUCT AND COMMUNITY STANDARDS

As of November, 82% of students participating in a conduct hearing strongly or somewhat agreed their behavior changed as a result of their alleged incident.

SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & EDUCATION CENTER

In November, SAPEC facilitated 20 prevention/awareness programs, an increase of more than 17% from 2018.

STUDENT MONEY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

Student Money Management Services had a total of 25 initial appointments in November, compared to 28 in November 2018.

KU RECREATION SERVICES

KU Recreation Services held a total of 62 personal training sessions during November, an increase of more than 14% from the previous month.

KU STUDENT HOUSING

After participating in KU Student Housing's "Who Am I?" activity, 86% of residents were able to explain their social identities.

WATKINS HEALTH SERVICES

In November, Watkins had 4,066 appointments, an increase of more than 5% from November 2018.

LEGAL SERVICES FOR STUDENTS

As a result of meeting with an LSS attorney or intern, 100% of clients indicated they would recommend LSS to a friend facing a legal issue.

STUDENT SUPPORT AND CASE MANAGEMENT

Student Support and Case Management managed a total of 71 student cases, compared to 79 in November 2018.

HILLTOP CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

Hilltop Child Development Center employed a total of 82 KU students, an increase of more than 18% from November 2018.

COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

CAPS had a total of 154 initial appointments, an increase of more than 18% from November 2018.

KU MEMORIAL UNION

KJHK had 6,184 website visits, an increase of more than 117% from November 2018.

In addition, KU Dining Services served free meals to 82 veterans and active duty military personnel on Veterans Day, an increase of more than 22% from 2018.
