APRIL 2020

STUDENT CONDUCT & **COMMUNITY STANDARDS**

SCCS ajudicated a total of 18 conduct cases, a 58% decrease from April 2019.

SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & **EDUCATION CENTER**

In April, SAPEC hosted five virtual events in support of Sexual Assault Awareness Month.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT & LEADERSHIP CENTER

SILC's Instagram page had 21,909 views during Jayhawk Impact Awards Recognition Week.

LEGAL SERVICES FOR STUDENTS

In April, LSS filed 157 tax returns on behalf of KU students and international researchers, a 6% increase from April 2019.

WATKINS HEALTH SERVICES

Watkins Health Services providers conducted 305 telemedicine appointments in April.

KU MEMORIAL UNION

In April, SUA's Socially Distant Queens Drag Show had 75 viewers throughout its two hour Instagram Live broadcast.

HILLTOP CHILD DEVELOPMENT **CENTER**

In April, 69% of Hilltop staff felt they knew how to collaborate effectively with workplace peers, an 18% increase from fall 2019.

COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

CAPS assisted a total of 359 students during the month of April.

STUDENT SUPPORT & CASE **MANAGEMENT**

Student Support and Case Management received a total of 63 student referrals in April.

KU RECREATION SERVICES

By the end of April, 310 KU students, staff, and faculty were participating in the NIRSA Recreation Movement program, an increase of more than 203% from the program's first week. All KU community members can sign up to participate at 2020recreationmovement.com through May 31st.

KU STUDENT HOUSING

As of April, KU Student Housing staff safely checked out 3,828 residents, deferred move out for residents unable to return to campus, and continued to provide services for 457 residents remaining in housing facilities.

In addition, KU Student Housing donated approximately 8,441 **pounds of food** to five local agencies. Donated food stemmed from the early closings of scholarship hall community kitchens.
