CENTER FOR SEXUALITY & GENDER DIVERSITY

In February, SGD opened its new Center in the Kansas Union and welcomed **89 visitors** during the month.

COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

CAPS assisted **531 students**, compared to 745 students in February 2020.

EMILY TAYLOR CENTER FOR WOMEN & GENDER EQUITY

As part of One Day. One KU., ETC received enough donations to unlock a **\$10,000 pledge** from ETC Advisory Board members to support continued programming.

HILLTOP CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

Hilltop had a total enrollment of **291 children**, compared to 298 in February 2020.

KU MEMORIAL UNION

SUA had **28,300 Instagram impressions**, a 31% increase from February 2020.

KU RECREATION SERVICES

Ambler Student Recreation Fitness Center had **27,684 access card swipes**, an increase of more than 39% from the start of the fall 2020 semester.

KU STUDENT HOUSING

In February, **173 residents** participated in Black History Month events within their housing communities.

OFFICE OF MULTICULTURAL AFFAIRS

In February, **43 students, staff and faculty** participated in the OMA's virtual First Generation Dinner and Open House program.

SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & EDUCATION CENTER

As of February, **459 students** were enrolled in SAPEC's Gender Based Violence Prevention Seminar (LDST 301 - 303), an increase of more than 141% from spring 2020.

SORORITY & FRATERNITY LIFE

In February, **238 prospective students** participated in the first of four virtual SFL Preview Day events.

STUDENT CONDUCT & COMMUNITY STANDARDS

As of February, **92% of students** participating in a conduct hearing were able to identify specific strategies for changing behavior and avoiding future conduct violations.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT & LEADERSHIP CENTER

After participating in Student Organization Events Protocol Training, **100% of participants** felt confident in their ability to plan an event while following the Protect KU guidelines and event organizer responsibilities.

STUDENT MONEY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

SMMS assisted **14 students** through initial individual appointments, an increase of more than 16% from February 2020.

STUDENT SUPPORT & CASE MANAGEMENT

SSCM received **62 student referrals**, compared to 70 referrals in February 2020.

WATKINS HEALTH SERVICES

The Health Education Resource Office's Sex in the Dark event had a total of **67 participants**, an increase of more than 36% from 2020.
