

Student Affairs is committed to engaging the KU community in services and programs that make learning possible. The information presented below highlights our work for February 2019.

WATKINS HEALTH SERVICES

Watkins treated a total of 334 students for flu and flu-like illnesses, down from 405 students in February 2018.

KU STUDENT HOUSING

A total of 290 students interviewed to serve as undergraduate staff members for the 2019 - 2020 academic year, a 16% increase from last year.

COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

CAPS conducted a total of 154 initial assessments, an increase of more than 52% from February 2018.

STUDENT MONEY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

SMMS staff assisted a total of 14 students through individual appointments, compared to 15 in February 2018.

KU RECREATION SERVICES

In February, there were a total of 50,530 access card swipes at Ambler SRFC, an increase of more than 3% from February 2018.

HILLTOP CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

During February, Hilltop Child Development Center employed a total of 70 KU students, an increase of more than 12% from February 2018.

STUDENT CONDUCT AND COMMUNITY STANDARDS

After participating in SCCS' Hawk Habits program, 88% of student participants indicated they learned the most from the program's personal values assessment activity.

SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & EDUCATION CENTER

SAPEC facilitated or participated in a total of 30 trainings and/or awareness events, an increase of 3% from February 2018.

KU MEMORIAL UNION

As of February, 19 students were enrolled in KU Memorial Unions' event development and management course, an increase of more than 11% from last year's inaugural course.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT & LEADERSHIP CENTER

After participating in SILC's Adding to Your Leadership Toolbox: A Social Media Approach program, 100% of student participants felt they gained a better understanding of using social media in support of their student organization.
