

APRIL 2017 UPDATE

As a division, Student Affairs is committed to engaging the KU community in services and programs that complement students' academic goals and enhance their quality of life. The information presented below highlights our work for April 2017.

WATKINS HEALTH SERVICES

In April, 56% of surveyed KU students strongly agreed that by maintaining good personal health and wellness they are more likely to achieve their academic goals.

STUDENT MONEY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

A total of 300 people participated in SMMS' Cash Carnival. More than 100 prizes were given away during the event, including gift cards, coupons and KU merchandise.

HILLTOP CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

Hilltop Child Development Center had a total enrollment of 290 children in April.

KU RECREATION SERVICES

Student Personal Trainers provided a total of 280 personal training sessions in April.

COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

CAPS had 1,125 appointments during the month of April, an increase of more than 2% from April 2016.

STUDENT CONDUCT & COMMUNITY STANDARDS

As of April, SCCS has provided over 25 hours of training for University Hearing Panel members.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT & LEADERSHIP CENTER

A total of 9 awards were given to student organizations, programs, and advisors during the recent Jayhawk Choice Awards.

KU MEMORIAL UNION

As a result of participating in The Big Event, 76% of students felt more connected to the KU and Lawrence community.

KU STUDENT HOUSING

A total of 113 staff members created passive educational bulletin boards focused on Sexual Assualt Awareness and Prevention in April.

LEGAL SERVICES FOR STUDENTS

After participating in LSS tax workshops, 95% of participants agreed or strongly agreed they are more confident in their ability to obtain assistance in dealing with legal issues and obligations.

SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & EDUCATION CENTER

SAPEC hosted 19 unique events on three campuses during Sexual Assault Awareness Month.

As a result of participating in *Not in My Yard* with Chimi Boyd Keys, 98% of student participants were able to identify an active bystander intervention strategy.
