

*Student Affairs is committed to engaging the KU community in services and programs that make learning possible. The information presented below highlights our work for February 2018.*

#### **WATKINS HEALTH SERVICES**

During peak influenza season in February, WHS treated a total of 405 student flu cases throughout the month.

#### **KU STUDENT HOUSING**

In response to student feedback indicating a need for additional academic programming, KU Student Housing held a total of 19 events focused on academic success throughout the month of February.

#### **KU RECREATION SERVICES**

A total of 87 personal training packages were purchased, an increase of more than 148% from February 2017.

#### **COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES**

CAPS had a total of 37 triage and urgent care visits, an increase of more than 8% from February 2017.

#### **KU MEMORIAL UNION**

KU Memorial Union had a total of 173,127 impressions on their social media accounts, an increase of 41% from the previous month.

#### **LEGAL SERVICES FOR STUDENTS**

In February, LSS' VITA grant was increased by 48%. The additional funding will support LSS' continued tax preparation assistance efforts.

#### **STUDENT MONEY MANAGEMENT SERVICES**

SMMS staff assisted a total of 67 students through in-person and phone contacts, an increase of more than 131% from the previous month.

#### **HILLTOP CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER**

As a result of working at Hilltop, 85% of KU student part-time aides feel they can effectively lead small and large group classroom activities.

#### **STUDENT CONDUCT & COMMUNITY STANDARDS**

As of February, 77% of students meeting with SCCS staff recognized their behavior had an impact on the KU community.

#### **SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & EDUCATION CENTER**

SAPEC conducted a total of 29 presentations and awareness events, an increase of 45% from February 2017.

#### **STUDENT INVOLVEMENT & LEADERSHIP CENTER**

Three of the four Sorority & Fraternity councils received awards at the annual Association of Fraternal Leadership & Values (AFLV) conference.
