

Student Affairs is committed to engaging the KU community in services and programs that make learning possible. The information presented below highlights our work for June, July, and August 2017.

WATKINS HEALTH SERVICES

WHS collected a total of 4,250 immunization forms from incoming students, an increase of more than 5% from summer 2016.

KU STUDENT HOUSING

In August, more than 700 students attended KU Student Housing’s annual Rock-A-Hawk event.

LEGAL SERVICES FOR STUDENTS

During summer 2017, Legal Services for Students conducted eight trainings/presentations reaching a total of 838 students.

KU RECREATION SERVICES

A total of 396 female students used the Ambler Student Recreation Fitness Center, an increase of more than 24% from summer 2016.

COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

CAPS had 1,472 appointments during June, July, and August 2017, an increase of more than 4% from the same time period in 2016.

STUDENT CONDUCT & COMMUNITY STANDARDS

After participating in Student Conduct’s summer conduct mini-course, 100% of participants felt they had a deeper understanding of the role of student conduct on college campuses.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT & LEADERSHIP CENTER

A total of 794 women accepted chapter bids during Panhellenic Sorority Recruitment, an increase of more than 7% from 2016.

STUDENT MONEY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

Student Money Management Services’ peer educators assisted a total of 56 students during June, July, and August.

KU MEMORIAL UNION

In August, the Kansas Union’s annual UnionFest was attended by a total of 8,194 individuals, an increase of more than 39% from 2016.

HILLTOP CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

Hilltop had a total enrollment of 314 children during summer 2017, an increase of more than 12% from summer 2016.

SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & EDUCATION CENTER

As of August, 100% of new student athletes have completed Gender Based Violence Recognition and Response training.

After completing *Think About It: II* training, 87% of returning students felt more confident participating in bystander intervention.
