CENTER FOR SEXUALITY & GENDER DIVERSITY

In April, SGD held its Drive-In Drag Show with **750 spectators** in attendance.

COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

CAPS assisted **604 students**, an increase of more than 52% from April 2020. In addition, CAPS had a total of **83 initial appointments**, an increase of more than 277% from April 2020.

HILLTOP CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

Hilltop had a total enrollment of **291 students**, which is consistent with the previous month.

KU MEMORIAL UNION

After participating in The Big Event, **91% of job site managers** felt more connected to campus and the KU community, an increase of more than 6% from The Big Event in 2019.

KU RECREATION SERVICES

In April, KU Recreation Services' Personal Training program sold **\$455 in personal training sessions**, an increase of more than 33% from the previous month.

LEGAL SERVICES FOR STUDENTS

LSS provided **90 virtual tax workshops with 977 student participants**, compared to seven in-person workshops held before the beginning of the pandemic last year.

OFFICE OF MULTICULTURAL AFFAIRS

In April, **27 KU community members** participated in the OMA's Spotlight Series Program featuring Charlesia McKinney.

SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & EDUCATION CENTER

In April, SAPEC hosted **11 Sexual Assault Awareness Month (SAAM) events**, a 120% increase from April 2020. In addition, there were **1,667 attendees** across all SAAM events, an increase of more than 42% from April 2020.

SORORITY & FRATERNITY LIFE

In April, **205 prospective students** participated in the Panhellenic Association's (PHA) virtual Preview Day event.

STUDENT CONDUCT & COMMUNITY STANDARDS

In April, SCCS had a total of **46 conduct cases**, an increase of more than 155% from April 2020.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT & LEADERSHIP CENTER

After participating in SILC's First-Year Leadership Connection program, **83% of participants** felt more connected to the KU campus.

STUDENT MONEY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

SMMS assisted **14 students** through initial, follow up, and final appointments, compared to 36 students in April 2020.

STUDENT SUPPORT & CASE MANAGEMENT

In April, SSCM received **133 student referrals**, an increase of more than 111% from April 2020.

WATKINS HEALTH SERVICES

In April, Watkins providers conducted **204 telemedicine appointments**, compared to 305 telemedicine appointments in April 2020.
