

Student Affairs is committed to engaging the KU community in services and programs that make learning possible. The information presented below highlights our work for April 2018.

STUDENT MONEY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

SMMS held six events during Financial Literacy Month, reaching a total of 788 students and community members, a 13% increase from the previous year.

KU MEMORIAL UNION

After participating in The Big Event, 88% of students indicated they would continue volunteering while at KU, an increase of 15% from last year.

HILLTOP CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

Hilltop Child Development Center had a total of 60 part-time student staff, which is consistent with April 2017 staff numbers.

STUDENT CONDUCT & COMMUNITY STANDARDS

After serving on the University Hearing Panel, 81% of panel members found the experience professionally fulfilling, an increase of 6% from last year.

SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & EDUCATION CENTER

SAPEC hosted a total of 31 events during Sexual Assault Awareness Month, an increase of more than 63% from April 2017.

COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

In April, CAPS assisted a total of 659 students, an increase of more than 5% from April 2017.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT & LEADERSHIP CENTER

In April, a total of 176 individuals participated in SILC's newly restructured Sorority and Fraternity Life Experience Day.

LEGAL SERVICES FOR STUDENTS

After participating in LSS workshops, 94% of participants felt more confident in their ability to obtain assistance for future legal issues and obligations, which is consistent with April 2017 participant feedback.

KU STUDENT HOUSING

In April, KU Student Housing provided 14 tours of the new Stouffer Place Apartments to more than 70 KU staff members and prospective residents.

WATKINS HEALTH SERVICES

Watkins Health Services' annual Student Health Advisory Board survey yielded a total of 3,273 responses, an increase of more than 4% from April 2017.

KU RECREATION SERVICES

KU Recreation Services hosted its first Inclusive Recreation Extravaganza Event, with 60 individuals participating in sit volleyball, wheelchair basketball, and goal ball.
