

Student Affairs is committed to engaging the KU community in services and programs that make learning possible. The information presented below highlights our work for November 2018.

SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & EDUCATION CENTER

SAPEC facilitated 10 *Consent @ KU* sessions, compared to 11 in November 2017.

In recognition of their 2017 - 2018 program collaborations, SAPEC also received the Student Union Activities Board's 2018 University Support Award.

LEGAL SERVICES FOR STUDENTS

LSS notarized a total of 51 absentee ballots for the 2018 midterm election, an increase of more than 30% from the number of ballots notarized for the 2016 presidential election.

KU MEMORIAL UNION

The Student Union Activities Board's November events garnered a total of 29,624 attendees, an increase of more than 30% from November 2017.

HILLTOP CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

Hilltop Child Development Center had a total of 69 part-time staff members, which is consistent with November 2017 staff numbers.

STUDENT CONDUCT & COMMUNITY STANDARDS

After participating in SCCS' Student Hearing Board training, 95% of student participants indicated they were more familiar with the conduct process and policies.

KU RECREATION SERVICES

KU Recreation Services held a total of 374 personal training sessions, an increase of more than 49% from November 2017.

KU STUDENT HOUSING

Based on information obtained from KU Student Housing's Resident Connection Cards, 100% of respondents were able to identify at least three action items that would contribute to their academic success.

COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

CAPS assisted a total of 804 students, an increase of more than 14% from November 2017.

WATKINS HEALTH SERVICES

WHS administered 759 flu shots, an increase of more than 45% from November 2017.

WHS was also awarded two grants totaling \$35,000 to sustain its Jayhawk Buddy System efforts during the 2019 - 2020 academic year.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT & LEADERSHIP CENTER

As part of Nontraditional Student Week, SILC hosted more than 65 students at its Veteran and Nontraditional Student Brunch, an increase of more that 62% from 2017.
