

Student Affairs is committed to engaging the KU community in services and programs that make learning possible. The information presented below highlights our work.

#### **MAY 2020**

## STUDENT CONDUCT & **COMMUNITY STANDARDS**

In 2019 - 2020, SCCS adjudicated a total of **2,765 conduct cases**, a 32% decrease from 2018 - 2019.

# SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & **EDUCATION CENTER**

In 2019 - 2020, SAPEC facilitated 659 awareness/educational programs, an increase of more than 84% from 2018 - 2019.

## STUDENT INVOLVEMENT & LEADERSHIP CENTER

SILC received 43 Nontraditional Student Scholarship applications, an increase of more than 43% from 2019.

#### **LEGAL SERVICES FOR STUDENTS**

After receiving assistance from LSS, 98% of student clients indicated they understood the legal options related to their case.

#### KU STUDENT HOUSING

As a result of living in their community during the year, 89% of residents were able to define healthy habits regarding alcohol.

#### WATKINS HEALTH SERVICES

In May, Watkins assisted 249 student patients via telemedicine appointments.

#### KU MEMORIAL UNION

KJHK had 8,144 YouTube views, an increase of more than 23% from May 2019.

## HILLTOP CHILD DEVELOPMENT **CENTER**

Hilltop Child Development Center employed a total of 82 KU students during the year, an increase of more than 9% from 2018 - 2019.

## **COUNSELING &** PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

As of May, CAPS assisted 495 students via teletherapy appointments.

## STUDENT SUPPORT & CASE **MANAGEMENT**

In 2019 - 2020, Student Support and Case Management received 584 student referrals, an increase of more than 3% from 2018 - 2019.

## STUDENT MONEY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

In 2019 - 2020, SMMS staff assisted 245 students through individual one-on-one appointments.

#### **KU RECREATION SERVICES**

As of May, 360 KU students, staff, and faculty were participating in the NIRSA Recreation Movement program, an increase of more than 16% from April 2020.

#### **SORORITY & FRATERNITY LIFE**

In 2019 - 2020, there were **42 active** sorority and fraternity chapters, an increase of more than 2% from 2018 - 2019.
