LEGAL SERVICES FOR STUDENTS

In October, LSS notarized **139 presidential election absentee ballots**, an increase of more than 247% from 2016 and 202% from 2012.

KU STUDENT HOUSING

According to feedback collected by KU Student Housing's Association of University Residence Halls, **56% of residents** felt access or connection to other people in their room or community is the most impactful element of living on campus.

HILLTOP CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

Hilltop had a total enrollment of **277 children**, which is consistent with September 2020.

STUDENT SUPPORT & CASE MANAGEMENT

SSCM received **117 student referrals**, an increase of more than 25% from October 2019.

COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

CAPS had a total of **1,112 appointments**, compared to 1,348 appointments in October 2019.

WATKINS HEALTH SERVICES

In October, Watkins provided **1,295 COVID-19 resource kits** to students, staff, and faculty. Kits included a reusable mask, hand sanitizer, and an information card with guidance for staying well.

STUDENT MONEY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

SMMS assisted **16 students** through initial individual appointments, compared to 22 students in October 2019.

SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & EDUCATION CENTER

SAPEC offered **68 Gender Based Violence Prevention Seminar sections**, an increase of more than 161% from 2019.

KU RECREATION SERVICES

KU Recreation Services assisted **55 personal training clients**, an increase of more than 7% from October 2019.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT & LEADERSHIP CENTER

After participating in SILC's Advisor Training Workshop, **100% of participants** felt more confident in their role as student organization advisors.

SORORITY & FRATERNITY LIFE

In partnership with the Hispanic Development Fund of Kansas City, Phi Iota Alpha Fraternity, Inc. raised more than **\$7,837** to support scholarships for Dreamers at KU.

In support of Domestic Violence Awareness Month, Sigma Psi Zeta Sorority, Inc. raised more than **\$813** from their *Believe Survivors* shirt fundraiser. A portion of the proceeds will be donated to Safehome, a women's shelter in Johnson County.
