

Student Affairs is committed to engaging the KU community in services and programs that make learning possible. The information presented below highlights our work for October 2019.

STUDENT CONDUCT AND COMMUNITY STANDARDS

In October, SCCS had a total of 37 conduct cases, a decrease of 57% from 2018.

SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & EDUCATION CENTER

SAPEC facilitated 23 prevention/awareness trainings and events in October, an increase of more than 9% from 2018.

STUDENT MONEY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

Student Money Management Services had a total of 30 initial appointments in October, an increase of more than 76% from 2018.

KU RECREATION SERVICES

In October, KU Recreation Services saw a 5.8% increase in Facebook page views compared to September 2019.

KU STUDENT HOUSING

A total of 274 individuals participated in KU Student Housing's Halloween in the Halls event, a 37% increase from 2018.

KU MEMORIAL UNION

A total of 236 students volunteered during the annual Mini Big Event, an increase of more than 43% from 2018.

WATKINS HEALTH SERVICES

Watkins Health Services administered 2,900 flu vaccines, an increase of more than 46% from 2018.

STUDENT SUPPORT AND CASE MANAGEMENT

Student Support and Case Management received 80 student referrals, which is consistent with October 2018.

HILLTOP CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

Hilltop Child Development Center employed a total of 84 KU students, an increase of more than 7% from September 2019.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT & LEADERSHIP CENTER

SILC's annual Trunk-or-Treat event had 35 registered trunks from student organizations, campus departments, and community groups, an increase of more than 45% from 2018.

NPHC hosted its annual step show to a sold out crowd of over 480 students/community members. Four KU Chapters participated and raised over \$2,000 to support NPHC's educational opportunities.
