

Student Affairs is committed to engaging the KU community in services and programs that make learning possible. The information presented below highlights our work for September 2019.

WATKINS HEALTH SERVICES

Watkins Health Services had a total of 4,296 appointments during September, an increase of more than 5% from 2018.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT & LEADERSHIP CENTER

After attending Student Organization Training, 86% of student attendees could identify KU resources available to assist their organization.

HILLTOP CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

Hilltop Child Development Center employed a total of 78 KU students, an increase of more than 14% from September 2018.

STUDENT CONDUCT AND COMMUNITY STANDARDS

In September, SCCS had a total of 96 conduct cases, an increase of more than 95% from 2018.

SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION & EDUCATION CENTER

In September, SAPEC facilitated 27 education trainings/awareness events across campus, an 80% increase from 2018.

OFFICE OF THE VICE PROVOST

The KU Campus Cupboard had a total of 436 visits in September, an increase of more than 315% from September 2018.

KU RECREATION SERVICES

In September, KU Recreation Services launched its first Unified Flag Football Intramural League—joining KU students with Special Olympian athletes—with 18 students across three teams.

STUDENT SUPPORT AND CASE MANAGEMENT

Student Support and Case Management received a total of 70 Care referrals during September, an increase of more than 4% from September 2018.

COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

In September, CAPS had a total of 218 initial appointments, an increase of more than 63% from 2018.

KU STUDENT HOUSING

After attending KU Student Housing alcohol and drug education events, 89% of respondents were able to define healthy habits regarding alcohol and other drugs.

LEGAL SERVICES FOR STUDENTS

Legal Services for Students was awarded a \$39,085 VITA grant from the IRS to continue its tax preparation assistance efforts, an increase of more than \$9,000 from 2018.
